### Minocqua’s “Spring Clean-Up Week” May 4th, 2015

The Town of Minocqua offers a “Spring Clean-Up Week” each year for property owners to have ordinary yard debris picked up and disposed of free of charge. Spring Clean-Up Week is usually scheduled for the first full week in May. Conditions allowing, Spring Clean-Up Week will start on May 4th, 2015.

**To ensure that your yard debris gets picked up, it must be placed at the roadside by 8:00 A.M. on May 4th, 2015. If debris is not placed by that time, Town crews cannot not make return trips to individual residences.**

#### **IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN PROGRAM:**

- Debris must be placed at the nearest Town, County, State or U.S. road (debris will not be picked up from private roads or easements) by 8:00 A.M. on May 4th, 2015
- Do not place debris piles underneath overhead lines or other obstructions if there are other options (crews may not pick it up)
- Make debris piles as compact as possible; if debris requires multiple stacks or piles, arrange them parallel with the roadway (running along the road, not perpendicular to the road)
- Leaves, needles, pine cones, etc., must be bagged
- No logs, trunks or stumps larger than 6 inches in diameter
- Maximum length for any material is 8 feet
- Spring Clean Up service is intended for ordinary yard debris only (bagged leaves, brush, small limbs); it is not meant for large stumps, trunks or excessive amounts of material (if it looks like more than two pickup truck loads, it’s probably too much)
- Pick up is limited to naturally-occurring materials only (no lumber or other construction materials, no man-made or processed items)
- Debris being picked up must be from that address; do not bring in materials from other locations
- Crews cannot not make return trips to pick up debris that was not placed at roadside by May 4th Don’t take chances! To ensure pickup, place your debris roadside by 8:00 A.M. on May 4th

**In order to keep costs down, the above requirements are strictly enforced.
